Text: Exodus 12

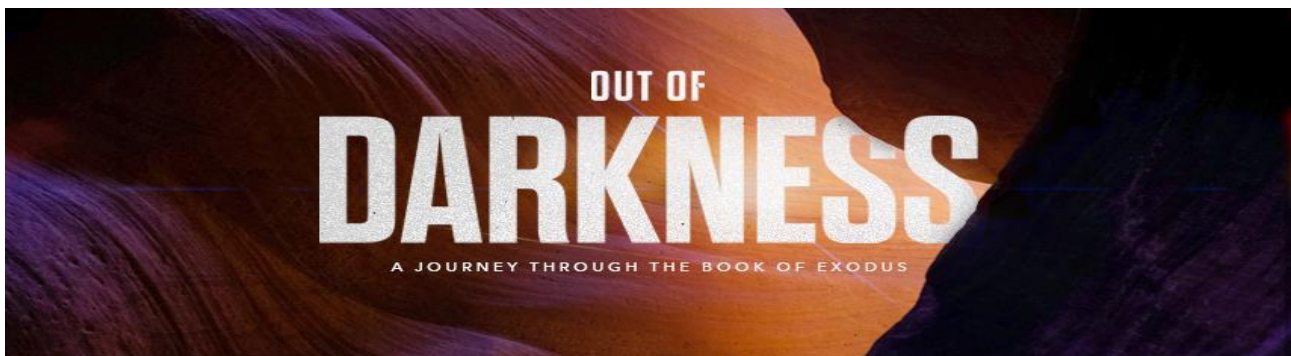
Topic(s): Sacred Name, Ten Plagues and gods
