Inspired By the True blue-Skinned people of Kentucky and the Brave and dedicated Kentucky Pack Horse Library service of the 1930s, The Book Woman of Troublesome Creek is a story of raw courage, fierce strength and one woman's belief that books can carry us anywhere—even back home.

"Sleep Pray Heal" by Donna Fado Ivery. The story of Donna's Journey as a United Methodist Pastor who suffers a life altering injury and the lessons she learns as she works her way back. The 2019 writer of the Year Award Winner.

"A Knock at Midnight" by Brittany K Barnett. This author tells of her mother's Incarceration, and how she came to be a lawyer. At one point in her career she realizes a case she is working on Involves the crime her mother was sent to prison for.
